ABSTRACT SUBMISSION RULES

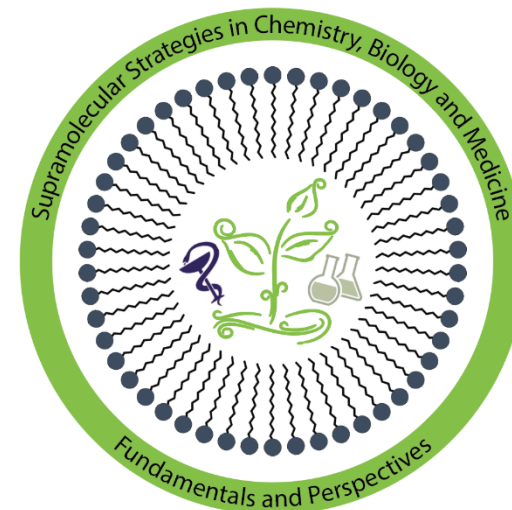
Single page abstracts must be prepared in electronic form as a MS Word document (template is attached) and sent to the committee address (e-mail: rsflabconf2019@gmail.com). Abstracts are sent in the file with the last name of attendee (for instance, Smith.docx). The whole text, including the headings is printed on an A4 page (210×297 mm) with 2.5 cm margins in the following order: title (capitalized, semibold); blank row; authors' last names with initials, speaker's name – underlined; blank row; Affiliated institutions (title case, italic). The whole heading section is centrally aligned. After another blank row, follows the abstract text: justified, 1 cm space between paragraphs, single line spacing, Times New Roman font, 12 pt size. References in text are enclosed into square parentheses. The reference list is printed after a blank row with a title «REFERENCES» (center-aligned): capitalized, font size 12 pt. References are listed as a numbered list, justified. The registration form should be completed on the conference website.
